This one story wood frame rectangular residence has a gable roof, a tall hip roof enclosed 7/8 front porch and a hip roof rear addition. Other features include an interior brick chimney. exposed rafters, diagonal braces with purling and decorative wood work in the gable corners, 1/1 double hung windows in wood surround. The front porch is sealed, with all the windows covered with plywood except two, and there is a 15 light wood front door with storm door. There is a cement foundation. New materials include' the plywood in the front porch, new cement stoop with two steps, ma and masonite siding. Outbuildings include: 1. rectangular wood frame garage with gable roof, wood roof shingles, overlap siding with corner boards, and casement hype garage doors of vertical! wood siding, no foundation. 2. A shed foof part open shed with vertical board siding and asphalt roofing. 3. Old outhouse with asphalt gable roof, horizontal board siding, and half moon cut in wall.
