This one-story wood frame rectangular residence has a gable roof, an enclosed gable roof one-half front porch, and an open covered deck to the rear. Other features include interior brick chimney, extended eaves with purlins and exposed rafters, windows in wood surround, 1/1 row windows in the enclosed porch, and a cement foundation. Modern materials include masonite siding and asphalt roof shingles.

To the back is a rectangular gable roof garage with exposed rafters, asphalt roof shingles, beveled edge siding with corner boards onea tall (3% foot) bare cement foundation.

Architecturally significant is the purlins, and gable end decoration. This is a contributing structure.
