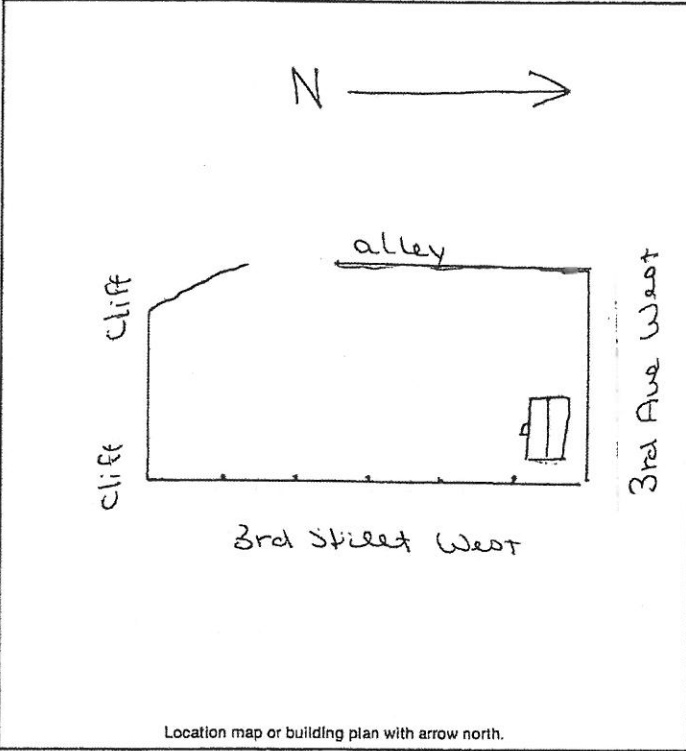

This simple one-story rectangular wood-frame residence has a gable roof with extended eaves and an exterior stretcher bond brick chimney. Other features include: asphalt roof shingles, 1/1 sliding windows and double hung windows, a fixed rectangular front window, and masonite siding. The building has a concrete block foundation and cement steps up to the front door. There is an awning with iron posts over the front stoop.

There is a small tin storage shed near the chimney; no foundation.

This is a neutral structure.
