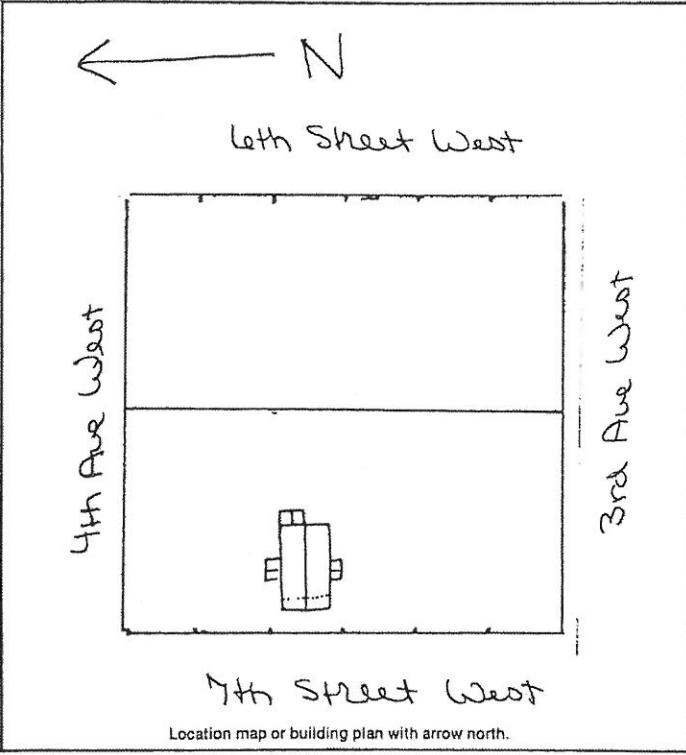

This long, large, one-story residence has a gable roof and a small gable roof addition to the rear. The front of the house is recessed under the gable roof creating a large open front porch. Extended roof beams from the house support the porch ceiling. At each side is a doorway, each with a gabled overhang, supported by a row of curved logs with a long collar and king post in the gable. The logs are round with notches in the corners, and have tar chinking. There are many rectangular multilight fixed windows, three wood overlaid wood doors, asphalt roof shingles and a cement foundation..

This is an intrusive structure.
