


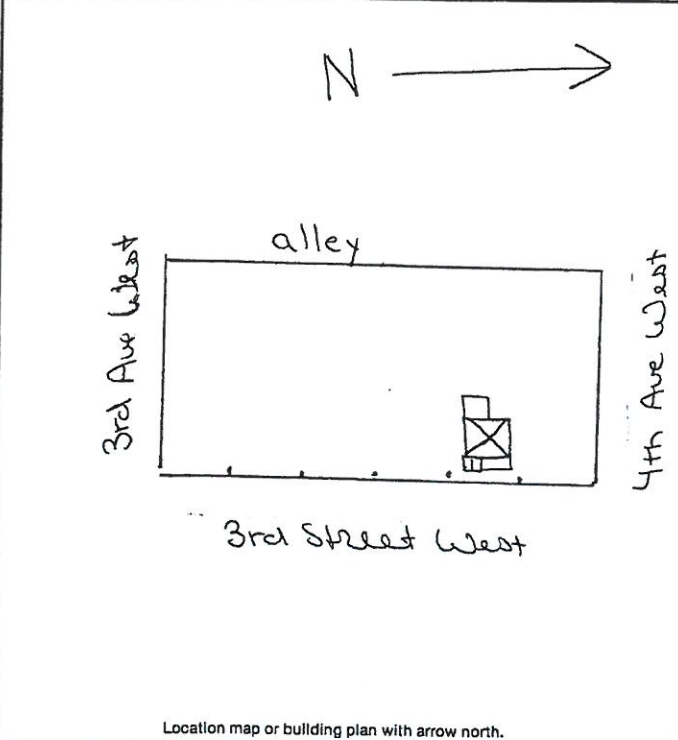

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: Describe present appearance of structure/site, then contrast and compare that with it's original appearance, noting additions, alterations, and changes in materials. Discuss significant architectural features.

A square two-story wood frame residence with pyramidal hip roof, upper and lower bays, a front porch, rear two-story hipped roof extension, rear porch, and concrete foundation. Roof has interior brick chimney, pedimented dormer extending eaves with crown cornice molding and composition shingles. Upper and lower floors have semi-hexagonal bays. Front porch was hip roof, square posts on clapboard siding with end boards, and architrave on upper floor, wood frame, double-hung windows with wood-surround trim; door is wood with small lights wood frame and wood-surround trim.

This is a contributing structure.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE: Justify how the persons, important events, and/or historical patterns associated with the structure/site and surrounding area lend the property significance.

Alex Gritz was a miner for the Roundup Coal Company Mine No. 3, 1910, 1914, 1916. He owned this residence and lived here from 1916 to 1953.
