

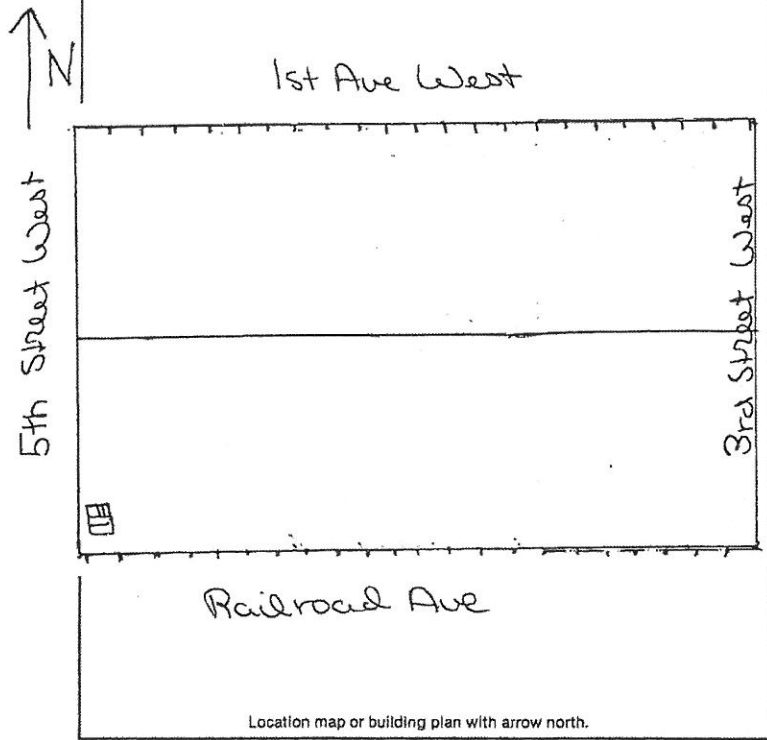

This small, one-story, square wood-frame residence has intersecting gable roofs and a shed roof side addition. Other features include wood shingles on the roof, rough cut lumber horizontal siding, asphalt roofing on the shed roof addition, modern aluminum frame sliding fixed windows, modern wood door, and a cement foundation.

This is a neutral structure.
