Gable roof has enterior brick chimney, wood shingles, eaves with fascia. Windows are wood frame, double hung 1/1 with wood surround.

Front door has wood frame panels with one light and wood surround. Front porch consists of wood stoop, and corrugated plastic awning with 2 X 4 wood support posts and railing. Rear shed roof extension has masonite shake siding and composition sheet roof.
