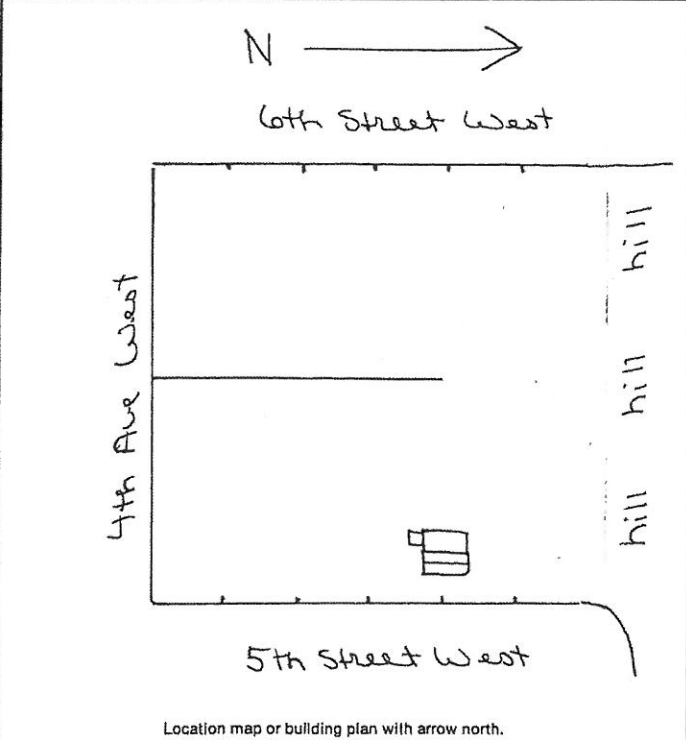

A small, one-story wood-frame residence with gable roof, with several shed roof rear extensions, horizontal beveled board siding and concrete foundation. Roof has interior brick chimney, wood shingles, eaves with fascia. Windows are wood-frame, double-hung 6/6 x 1/1, and sliding, with wood-surround. Numerous small evergreen trees in front yard obscure view of front doors and windows. Rear side porch has shed roof, fixed wood frame windows and wood frame door with panels and wood shingle siding. Adjoining shed extension with shed roof, wood shingle-siding and sheet metal roof is located at rear of residence.

This is a neutral structure.
