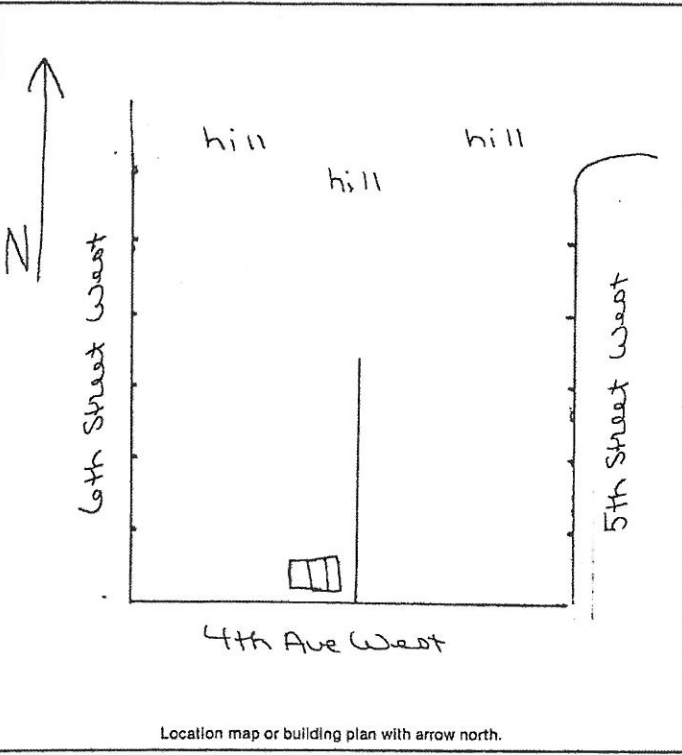

A rectangular wood-frame garage with a gable roof, simulated brick composition siding with end boards, and wood frame, vertically hung, vertical board double garage door. Roof has composition sheet siding & eaves with fascia. Garage has shed roof extensions to east & west. East extension is open carport with vertical wood paneled siding. West extension has corrugated metal shed roof with vertical fibre board grooved siding with wood frame door with panels and 4 lights (with wood surround). This is a neutral structure.
