This rectangular, one-story, small, wood-frame residence has a gable roof and a side shed roof open porch and a rear shed roof addition. Other features include an interior brick chimney, exposed rafters, 4/4 wood slide rectangular windows, wood panel door, wood shingle siding. Modern materials include asphalt roofing, plywood shed roof back addition, and shed roof side morch of wood board flooring, wood board rail, and raw wood square porch supports.
