

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

Sec. 13-1. Extermination and removal of nuisance weeds.

- (a) In case any lot owner neglects or refuses to cut, remove and eradicate from such lot and one-half of the street, avenue or alley upon which said lot abuts, all thistles, dandelions, sweet clover, and weeds of any kind, as herein denominated nuisances, on or before May 1 of each year, or thereafter within seven days of notice from the city, the city shall cause all such weeds and nuisances to be cut and eradicated.
- (b) The city clerk-treasure shall keep an accurate account of the expense of cutting, removing and eradicating all such nuisance on each lot and certified shall be assessed against each such lot where such weed and nuisances have been removed from such lot, or the one-half of the street, avenue or alley upon which said lot abuts. Nonpayment imposed may be taken as a lien upon the property and is enforceable as is nonpayment of property taxes as a special tax against the property.
- (c) This section applies to the whole of the city.
